Project proposal description

Description of the project idea

The project is focused on the "green" transformation of the Boryslav community through the optimization of municipal waste management. Given the lack of local recycling facilities, the initiative aims to establish a high-quality system for primary waste separation and consolidation to prepare materials for further industrial processing. We plan to implement innovative solutions for the circular economy by focusing on reducing waste generation and sorting at the source. The project includes the modernization of waste collection infrastructure (installation of "smart" containers and sorting stations) and the development of efficient logistics for transporting sorted fractions to regional recycling centers. A key component is promoting the "Zero Waste" concept and raising environmental awareness among residents and schools to reduce the burden on the municipal environment and foster sustainable resource use.

Expected role of the partner institution

Our partners are expected to share successful European practices in organizing municipal logistics for residual waste and "Zero Waste" strategies. We look forward to a collaborative approach where the partner organization assists in designing efficient waste sorting schemes and selecting optimal technical solutions for primary waste consolidation. Key aspects of our cooperation will include the joint development of project methodology, conducting educational workshops for Boryslav's specialists, and coordinating cross-border awareness campaigns to foster sustainable habits in both communities
