Description of the project idea

The project aims to improve municipal waste management systems and promote circular economy practices in the border communities of Ukraine and Poland.

The Ukrainian partner will set up waste sorting stations and collection points, install recycling bins in the town of Khyriv and its surrounding villages, procure composters for educational facilities, and organize environmental clean-up campaigns for riverbanks and public areas.

The Polish partner will implement similar environmental measures within its territory, participate in joint study visits, exchange best practices, and run public awareness campaigns on waste management and the circular economy.

Working together, the partners will co-organize environmental events, training sessions, meetings, and awareness campaigns focused on waste sorting, recycling, and composting.

This cross-border initiative will improve environmental conditions, boost public ecological awareness, and implement modern waste management practices on both sides of the border.
