Project proposal description

Description of the project idea	<i>The project aims to develop an inclusive eco-educational nature trail near the administrative building of the Nature Conservation Research Department of the Kremenets Mountains National Nature Park, integrating principles of circular and resource-efficient economy. The trail will be designed as an accessible, barrier-free space for visitors of different ages and abilities, including people with disabilities. Its infrastructure will be created using sustainable and locally sourced materials, as well as elements of recycled and upcycled resources, demonstrating practical approaches to waste reduction and responsible resource use.</i> <i>The trail will include interactive and sensory installations, such as tactile objects, nature-based elements, and inclusive information boards adapted for visually impaired visitors. A key component of the project will be awareness-raising on circular economy principles, including waste prevention, reuse, and sustainable consumption, delivered through educational stations, guided activities, and workshops (including upcycling practices).</i> <i>The project will serve as a demonstration site combining inclusive access to nature with practical solutions for resource efficiency, promoting environmentally responsible behavior and strengthening cross-border cooperation in sustainable environmental education and innovation.</i>
Expected role of the partner institution	<i>The partner institution will play a key role in co-developing and implementing the project by providing expertise in circular economy practices, sustainable design, and inclusive environmental education. This includes joint planning of the eco-educational trail, selection of resource-efficient and recycled materials, and integration of upcycling and waste reduction solutions into the infrastructure and educational content. The partner will contribute to the development of interactive and sensory elements, support training of Park staff, and participate in pilot activities and workshops focused on circular economy principles. In addition, the partner will facilitate knowledge exchange and cross-border cooperation, contribute to</i>

communication and dissemination activities, and support the long-term sustainability and transferability of project results.
