Project proposal description

Description of the project idea	Healthcare facilities generate significant amounts of medical waste, including infectious, hazardous, pharmaceutical, and sharps waste. Improper segregation, collection, storage, transportation, and treatment of medical waste poses serious risks to public health, healthcare workers, patients, and the environment. The current problems caused by the war in Ukraine have increased the load on our medical institution. Thus, in 2025, 19,997 patients were treated at the Central Medical Center of the IF MR, and 9,000 surgical interventions were performed. The trend towards an increase in the number of patients annually continues, which, accordingly, leads to an increase in the generation of medical waste. Healthcare institutions on both sides of the border need modern, sustainable solutions for managing medical waste in order to preserve people's health and reduce environmental pollution. The project aims to strengthen cross-border cooperation between healthcare institutions in Poland and Ukraine by introducing improved practices, modern equipment, staff training, and joint environmental awareness activities.
Expected role of the partner institution	The Polish partner would: - Participate in project planning and implementation. - Share expertise and best practices in medical waste management and environmental protection. - Host study visits and training activities. - Contribute to the development of joint procedures and recommendations. - Participate in awareness-raising and dissemination activities. - Support monitoring and evaluation of project outcomes.
