Description of the project idea	The project aims to strengthen the operational capacity, technical reliability, and resource efficiency of water supply and wastewater utility companies through technical modernization and cross-border cooperation. The main focus of the project will be the procurement and implementation of modern equipment for municipal water and wastewater utilities. Planned purchases may include leak detection equipment, hydraulic tools, trench shoring systems, automatic samplers, pumping equipment, flow meters, shut-off valves, backup power supply systems, and other specialized equipment necessary for the operation and maintenance of water supply and wastewater infrastructure. The project will also support cooperation between Ukrainian and Polish partners through exchange of experience, study visits, joint workshops, and sharing of best practices related to utility management, energy efficiency, environmental protection, and sustainable operation of municipal infrastructure. The project will contribute to improving the quality and reliability of municipal services, increasing operational resilience of utility companies, and strengthening cross-border institutional cooperation.
Expected role of the partner institution	The partner institution is expected to participate in the joint preparation and implementation of the project, including exchange of expertise and best practices, participation in joint activities, dissemination of project results, and involvement in communication and capacity-building activities.

Preferably, the partner institution should act as the Lead Partner of the project and coordinate the overall project implementation and communication with the Program bodies.
