Description of the project idea	The Velykoberezovytsia Settlement Council aims to establish long-term partnerships with municipalities in European Union countries to implement joint initiatives within the framework of cross-border cooperation programmes and international technical assistance. The project aims to develop sustainable inter-municipal cooperation in key areas: local self-government and governance, education and youth development, culture and sport, digitalisation, energy efficiency and environmental protection. Particular emphasis will be placed on exchanging experience regarding the implementation of European approaches to community management, project preparation and implementation, securing funding, and adaptation to EU standards.

	Within the framework of the partnership, the following is planned: • organising exchange visits and study trips; • holding joint seminars, training sessions and public events; • preparing and submitting joint project applications under cross-border cooperation programmes (in particular Interreg, EU programmes and other donor initiatives); • implementing pilot projects aimed at community development and improving residents' quality of life. The partnership is envisaged as long-term and strategic, with a focus on the annual implementation of joint projects, the formation of sustainable links between communities and the creation of practical outcomes that will have a measurable impact on local development.
Expected role of the partner institution	The partner organisation is expected to play an active role in joint projects and initiatives, as well as to contribute its expertise, experience and best practices in the fields of local government, education, culture, youth policy, sport, digitalisation and community development. The partner will participate in the planning and implementation of activities such as exchange visits, seminars and public events, and will contribute to the development of sustainable and mutually beneficial projects that strengthen cooperation and mutual understanding between communities. Of particular importance is drawing on the partner organisation's experience regarding European integration processes,

specifically preparations for EU accession, the adaptation of policies and standards to European Union requirements, as well as the adoption of best practices in the preparation and implementation of international projects, the effective use of grant opportunities and the introduction of innovative approaches to community development.
