Project proposal description

Description of the project idea	The municipality is facing a critical environmental challenge due to the lack of functioning wastewater treatment facilities. The existing treatment infrastructure is obsolete and currently non-operational, resulting in insufficient wastewater treatment and creating risks for water resources, public health, and the environment. The project aims to develop sustainable solutions for wastewater management through cross-border cooperation with a Polish partner. Planned activities include the exchange of best practices, preparation of technical documentation, environmental assessments, and development of a concept for the construction of modern wastewater treatment facilities. The project will contribute to improved environmental protection and strengthen cooperation between local communities in the border region.
Expected role of the partner institution	The Polish partner is expected to share experience and best practices in wastewater management and environmental protection, participate in the development of project activities, support technical and environmental assessments, and contribute to the preparation of strategic and technical documentation. The partner will also take part in study visits, workshops, and awareness-raising activities aimed at strengthening cross-border cooperation and improving environmental sustainability.
